INVITATION

The Norwegian Photo Association, Norsk Selskap for Fotografi and Bekkalokket Photoclub cordially invites national teams of youth photographers, members of FIAP, to participate in the 41th FIAP Youth Biennial 2023.

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

The participation in the Biennial is free and is **ONLY open for the Operational Members** which have paid their annual membership fee.

Each federation will select itself the works (the collections) it wants to present. Images must be in digital format (traditional and/or mobile). No coherence is needed.

The participation will be in two age categories:

Category I: under the age of 16 before the closing date for entries (**born after 10/05/2007**)

Category II: under the age of 21 before the closing date for entries (**born after 10/05/2002**)

Each author can participate in only one category.

The entry is limited to **20 works** per federation with a **maximum of two (2) works per author and per age category**.

Files should be in JPG, sRGB, **300 dpi** (colour and/or black and white).

Image size: **2400 pixels minimum and 3500 pixels maximum** for the largest side. Maximum file size **6 MB**.

There are no requirements for special filenames, the files will be renamed automatically during upload.

All styles and creative techniques are allowed. The works must not have been sent to any previous FIAP Biennials. The images must not have any signature, text or distinctive mark on it.

WARNING: Nude works are strictly forbidden!

Each member of the jury will score each work from 1 to 9 points. The number of points of each work results from the addition of the points of the 3 members of the jury. The number of points of the collection results from the addition of the points of the 20 works. The country collection obtaining the highest number of points, wins the World Cup of the corresponding FIAP Youth Biennial category.

With the sole act of submitting his/her images or files to a FIAP Biennial, the entrant accepts without exception and with no objection:

- that the submitted images can be investigated by FIAP to establish if these obey to FIAP regulations and definitions even if the entrant is not a member of FIAP
- that FIAP will use any means at its disposal for this undertaking
- that any refusal to cooperate with FIAP or any refusal to submit the original files as captured by the camera, or failure to provide sufficient evidence, will be sanctioned by FIAP
- that in case of sanctions following the non-compliance with FIAP regulations, the name of the entrant will be released in any form useful to inform the breaches of the rules

It is recommended to leave the EXIF data in the submitted files intact in order to ease eventual investigations.

A declaration of consent and responsibility for the images will be provided. Registrations will not be accepted without the compliance of this declaration by the representative of the participating Operational Member.

AWARDS

Each section will be awarded as follows:

- FIAP World Cup** for the best national federation.
- FIAP Gold medal for the federation which comes second.
- FIAP Silver medal for the federation which comes third.
- FIAP Bronze medal for the federation which comes fourth.
- Six Honourable Mentions for the federations which come 5th to 10th.

The authors of the federation coming first receive an Honourable Mention.

Individual awards:

Each category: one FIAP Gold Medal, two FIAP Silver Medals and three FIAP Bronze medals will be awarded to works of exceptional quality, independently of the federation classification.

Additionally, the Norwegian Photo Association, Norsk Selskap for Fotografi (NSFF) will grant the following awards in each category: one NSFF Gold Medal, one NSFF Silver Medal, one NSFF Bronze Medal and two NSFF Honourable Mentions.

Each author can only receive one award (the mentions of the authors of the country ranked first are not taken into account).

CATALOGUE

A catalogue in pdf format will be published for both sections. All awarded works and at least one work per participating country will be reproduced.

The catalogue will be available for download on the FIAP website.
