Day 1 – September 1



Main Activities: All-day pickup at Xilinhot Airport(XIL). Photomeeting reception staff and volunteers will guide guests to board luxury coaches and check in at Yuanhe Jianguo Hotel, the only five-star hotel in Xilinhot.

| | 19:00 | Grand welcome banquet at the hotel ballroom hosted by the Inner Mongolia government and Xilinhot City (agenda TBD), featuring traditional Mongolian dance and etiquette with toasting rituals. |

| • | 14:00 | Photo session: Mongolian costumes, prairie lovers, Aobao meetings, sunset. |
| | 19:30 | Return to Yuanhe Jianguo Hotel. |

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| | 08:00 | Depart for Phoenix Horse Ranch to shoot: Mongolian horse catching, taming, horseback archery, Buzkashi (goat- grabbing on horseback), traditional Mongolian skills (20 km / 25 mins). |

| • | 12:00 | Lunch at the hotel. |
| • | 13:00 | Check out, pack luggage, and depart from Yuanhe Jianguo Hotel to West Ujimqin Banner. |
| | 14:00 | Take coaches from the Yuanhe Jianguo Hotel tto Chaidamu and Linmutu Lake (180km). Photograph scenery, camel migration, silhouettes of Mongolian horses, and prairie customs along the way (approx. 5 hours). |

Day 5– September 5

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| | 08:15 | Take coaches to Balagaar Nomadic Tribe and Banlashan Grassland for photography (approx.85 km/1 hour 20 minutes). |
| | 09:30 ~ 12:00 | Shoot the nomadic tribe and the stunning grassland scenery at Banlashan Grassland |
| | 12:00~14:00 | Lunch at the Balagaar Nomadic Tribe and experience nomadic life. |
| • | 14:00~18:00 | Shooting Mongolian nomadic life, the Ujumchin wedding performance, herders milking cows, boiling tea, and daily life of herder families. |
| | 18:30 ~ 21:30 | Take coaches (45 km) to Mongol Khan City for dinner and shoot the evening bonfire party. Guests from different countries could dance and sing with local herders, and enjoy traditional ethnic performances. |
| | 21:30 ~ 22:00 | Take coaches back to West Ujimqin Banner Government Hotel (approx. 20 km/ 30 minutes). |

| | 10:00 | Take coaches to Hongger Gacha in Abaga Banner for photography (horses galloping through the river, sunset by the lake) (265 km / 3.5 hours). Arrive at 14:30. Boxed lunch served on the bus to ensure shooting time. |
| • | 14:30 | Photography: Galloping horses through waves and horses bathing in the river. |
| | 16:30 | Return to Yuanhe Jianguo Hotel (120 km / 2 hours), check in, change into formal wear, organize works, and submit USB drives to the organizing committee before the dinner. |
| | 19:30~21:00 | Grand closing ceremony and farewell banquet of the 9th FIAP photomeeting at the hotel ballroom (agenda TBD). Formal attire required. Including Mongolian toasting ceremony, roast whole sheep, traditional etiquette and Ode to the Whole Sheep ceremony, Mongolian dance performance of Wulan Muqi, interaction between singer's toast and guest's toast and other etiquette. |
